




BPW officers checking in our members & guests (L to R) Suzi Youngberg, Jennifer Cappadona & Theresa Sutter.




Cheryl Meads speaks to the crowd of 70 members and guests.



Nancy Perez Miller

Life is what you make it. I believe this statement is somewhat true (a lot is owed to circumstances and family).


I was born in 1958 in Havana during the turmoil of the communist takeover. My grandparents were born in Spain; one set were shepherds; the other has a 'tower' on a hill that is still family owned. All four grandparents went to Cuba as teenagers to start a new life, and a financially successful one it was until 1959. At the end of 1966, after the Kennedy crisis, my immediate family including my parents and brothers arrived in Detroit. The requirements of the immigration process included having a financially responsible relative residing in the U.S. finances to survive for a year or 2 in Cuba, plus extra to make it happen. Freedom was not available to everyone.

On a Friday night, we arrived by airplane and picked up in a green station wagon. My older brother and I were thrilled to ride in the rear facing back seat watching snowflakes for our first time. The following Monday, we walked to school and my father started working at Chrysler. With his first paycheck, he was able to finance a new car. The Vietnam War was in progress, there was social upheaval and soon after race riots. It was a time of change for all. Thanks to the Catholic education received, Art and Goals became an integral part of me. We settled in a working class neighborhood where I lived until H.S. graduation and soon married. Although my son was born shortly after, I graduated cum laude at 20 from UD and resided in the Miami area. Ten years later, I obtained a second degree at UM. Soon after Hurricane Andrew, my daughter was born and we made the move to the Upper Keys; Islamorada, then Key Largo.

With few exceptions, my work experience has been Architecture and Construction. Although I am also a licensed Building Contractor, my passion is Design.

Reflecting on my life, it seems that I have been in a hurry to accomplish. Even in the Keys, that has not changed and I hope it never does.
